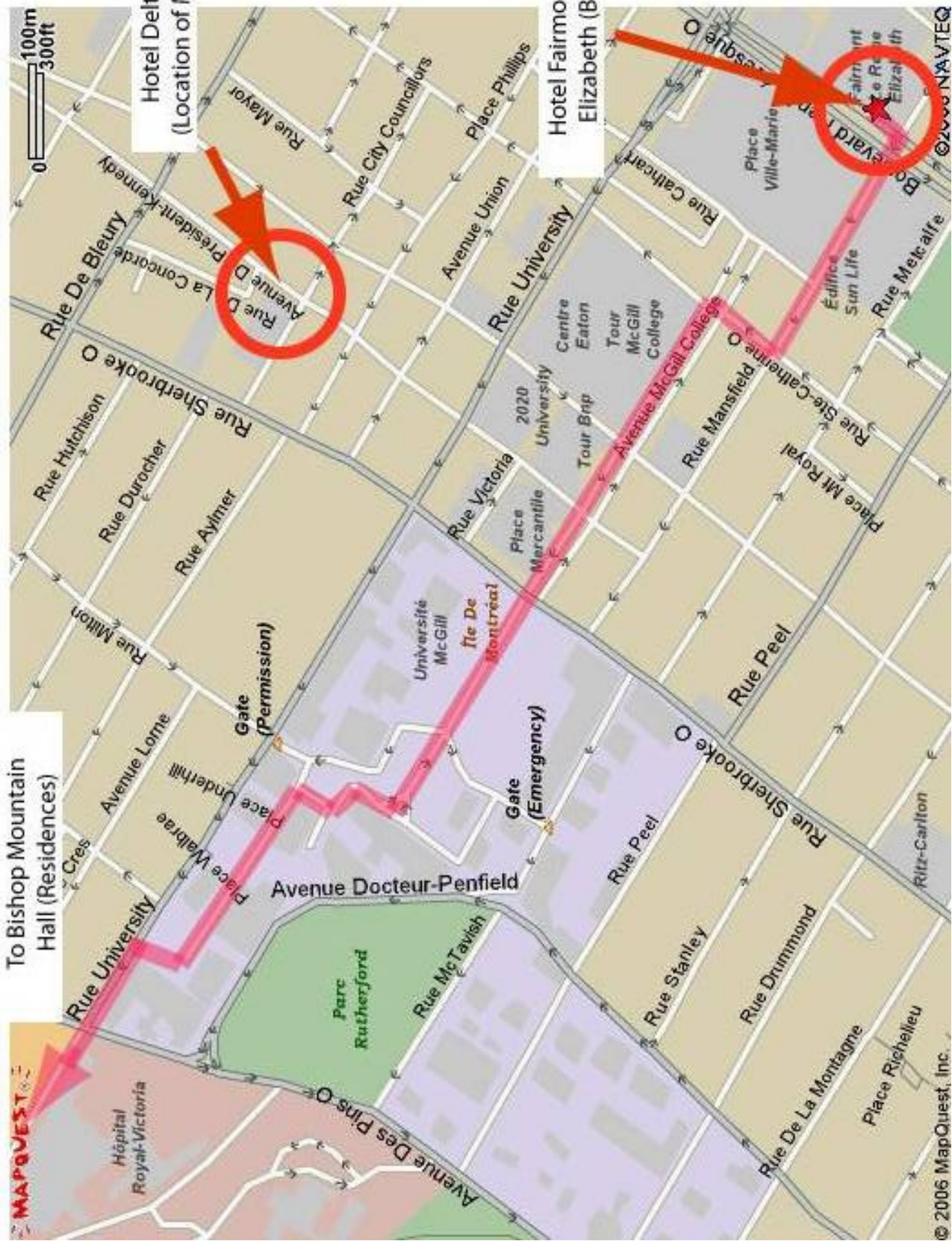

# Travel to McGill Residences...

Montreal, Qc, Canada



McGill University Residences are conveniently located in downtown Montreal and are easy to reach from Trudeau airport, the Central Train Station and the Berri Bus Terminal.

*Please consult the directions under your specific mode of transport.*

## By Car :

### From Toronto/Ottawa:

Take route 401 through to Highway 40. Follow Hwy. 40 to the Decarie Expressway (Hwy. 15 South). Continue to the Ville-Marie Expressway (Hwy. 720 East). Take the exit **Guy**. At the traffic light go straight (along St. Marc st.) until Sherbrooke. Turn right on Sherbrooke until you reach University Street. Turn left on University Street.

### From Vermont or New York:

Follow Highway 10 or 15 to the Champlain Bridge. Take the first exit to the Autoroute Bonaventure which will lead you to University Street.

### From Quebec City:

Follow Autoroute Jean-Lesage (Hwy. 20) to route 132. Continue towards La Prairie, following route 132 to the Champlain Bridge and then same as above.

Once on University Street (North of Sherbrooke), the first building on your right is the **Royal Victoria College** at 3425 University St. **Bishop Mountain Residences** at 3935 University St. are situated above Avenue des Pins past the Montreal Neurological Institute (up the hill left of the parking booth).

## By Plane:

The easiest and the most economical way to reach Residences from Trudeau airport is by taking a shuttle bus. Return tickets can be purchased if you are planning to go back to the airport the same way. The bus will take you to the **Bus Terminal** (connecting with Berri-UQAM metro station). **Please note:** A taxi ride from Trudeau airport directly to downtown Montreal will cost approximately \$35.

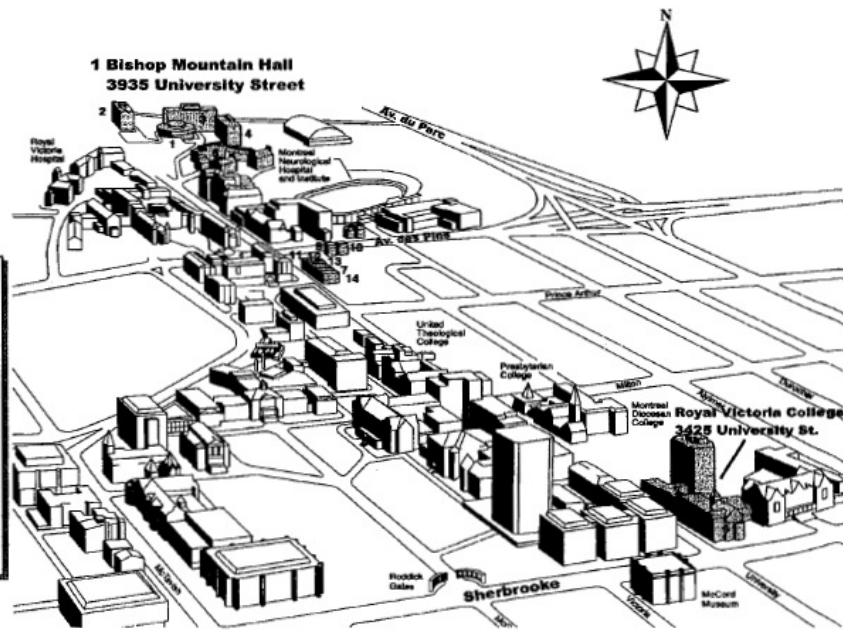
A taxi ride from downtown Montreal to the Bishop Mountain Residences should be between \$12 and \$15. Mention to the taxi driver that the McGill Residences are located at the very top of University Street, past the Montreal Neurological Institute. Before approaching the Halls, you will pass a security/parking booth on your right side.

## By Bus or Train:

From the **Berri Bus Terminal**, you may access both RVC and Bishop Mountain by taking the **green line** from the Berri-UQAM metro station, going towards Angrignon, and getting off at the **McGill metro station**. Take the **University exit** and you are 5 minutes from RVC and about 20 minutes from Bishop Mountain.

It is better to take a taxi to get to the Bishop Mountain Residences, especially if you are carrying heavy pieces of luggage. The ride from McGill metro should be about \$7 and about \$10-12 from the Central Train Station.
